Please refer to your supplemental new drug applications dated March 13, 2007, received March 14, 2007, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for the following:

- OMNICEF[®] (cefdinir) Capsules (NDA 50-739)
- OMNICEF[®] (cefdinir) Oral Suspension (NDA 50-749)

These “Changes Being Effected” supplemental new drug applications provide for revisions to the package inserts to include information relative to recent epidemiologic and scientific data regarding *Clostridium difficile* associated disease (CDAD).
