Dear Ms. Aiello:

Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated and received June 30, 2011, received July 1, 2011, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for Norvir[®] (ritonavir) Soft Gel Capsules, 100 mg.

We acknowledge receipt of your amendments dated November 21, 2011 and December 2, 2011.

This Prior Approval supplemental new drug application proposes the following changes:

1. To update WARNINGS, Drug Interactions subsection of the package insert (PI) with information regarding coadministration with CYP3A inhibitors.
2. To update PRECAUTIONS, Drug Interactions' Table 6 section of the PI with new information on drug interactions with fentanyl, dasatinib and nilotinib.
3. To update the ADVERSE REACTIONS, section of the PI with information related to toxic epidermal necrolysis (TEN).
4. To update the What should I tell my doctor before taking NORVIR? section of the patient package insert with new information on drug interactions with fentanyl, dasatinib and nilotinib.

We have completed our review of this supplemental application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA

automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at <http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm>. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert and the patient package insert), with the addition of any labeling changes in pending “Changes Being Effectuated” (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

Information on submitting SPL files using eLIST may be found in the guidance for industry titled “SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As” at <http://www.fda.gov/downloads/DrugsGuidanceComplianceRegulatoryInformation/Guidances/UCM072392.pdf>.

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(1)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit the following, in triplicate, (1) a cover letter requesting advisory comments, (2) the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and (3) the package insert(s) to:
