Warnings

Allergy alert: Ibuprofen may cause a severe allergic reaction which may include:

hives • facial swelling • asthma (wheezing) • shock

Alcohol warning: If you consume 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day, ask your doctor whether you should take ibuprofen or other pain relievers/fever reducers. Ibuprofen may cause stomach bleeding.

Do not use if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer

Ask a doctor before use if you have

- · never had migraines diagnosed by a health professional
- · a headache that is different from your usual migraines
- the worst headache of your life
- · fever and stiff neck
- headaches beginning after or caused by head injury, exertion, coughing or bending
- experienced your first headache after the age of 50
- daily headaches
- a migraine so severe as to require bed rest
- problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or fever reducers
- stomach pain

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

- under a doctor's care for any continuing medical condition
- taking other drugs on a regular basis
- taking another product containing ibuprofen, or any other pain reliever/fever reducer

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- an allergic reaction occurs. Seek medical help right away.
- migraine headache pain is not relieved or gets worse after first dose
- stomach pain occurs with the use of this product
- · new or unexpected symptoms occur

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofer during the last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery. Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

under 18 years of age:	• ask a doctor
