601	liver problems during treatment with VOTRIENT:
602	 yellowing of your skin or the whites of your eyes (jaundice)

605	nausea or vomiting

607	 pain on the right side of your stomach area (abdomen)
608	bruise easily

610	Your healthcare provider may need to prescribe a lower dose of VOTRIENT for you
611	or tell you to stop taking VOTRIENT if you develop liver problems during treatment.

613	What is VOTRIENT?
614	VOTRIENT is a prescription medicine used to treat advanced renal cell cancer in
615	adults.
616	It is not known if VOTRIENT is safe or effective in children under 18 years of age.
617	
618	What should I tell my healthcare provider before taking VOTRIENT?
619	Before you take VOTRIENT, tell your healthcare provider if you:
620	 have or had liver problems. You may need a lower dose of VOTRIENT or your
621	healthcare provider may prescribe a different medicine to treat your advanced
622	renal cell cancer.
623	have high blood pressure
624	 have heart problems or an irregular heartbeat including QT prolongation

625 626 627 628 629 630 631 632	 have a history of a stroke have coughed up blood in the last 6 months had bleeding of your stomach or intestines in the last 6 months have a history of a tear (perforation) in your stomach or intestine, or an abnormal connection between two parts of your gastrointestinal tract (fistula) have thyroid problems had recent surgery (within the last 7 days) or are going to have surgery have any other medical conditions
 633 634 635 636 637 638 	 are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. VOTRIENT can harm your unborn baby. You should not become pregnant while you are taking VOTRIENT. are breast-feeding or plan to breast-feed. It is not known if VOTRIENT passes into your breast milk. You and your healthcare provider should decide if you will take VOTRIENT or breast-feed. You should not do both.
 639 640 641 642 643 	Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take including prescription and non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. VOTRIENT may affect the way other medicines work and other medicines may affect how VOTRIENT works.

653 654 655	Ask your healthcare provider if you are not sure if your medicine is one that is listed above.
656 657 658	Know the medicines you take. Keep a list of them and show it to your healthcare provider and pharmacist when you get a new medicine.
659 660 661 662 663 664	 How should I take VOTRIENT? Take VOTRIENT exactly as your healthcare provider tells you. Your healthcare provider will tell you how much VOTRIENT to take. Your healthcare provider may change your dose. Take VOTRIENT on an empty stomach, at least 1 hour before or 2 hours after food.

- Do not crush tablets of VOTRIENT.
- Do not eat grapefruit or drink grapefruit juice during treatment with VOTRIENT.
 Grapefruit products may increase the amount of VOTRIENT in your body.
- If you miss a dose, take it as soon as you remember. Do not take it if it is close
 (within 12 hours) to your next dose. Just take the next dose at your regular
 time. Do not take more than 1 does of VOTDEENT at a time.

- Your healthcare provider will test your blood and heart before you start and

- 675 **VOTRIENT may cause serious side effects including:**

- bleeding problems. Symptoms may include: unusual bleeding, bruising,
 wounds that do not heal.
- heart attack or stroke. Symptoms may include: chest pain or pressure, pain
 in your arms, back, neck or jaw, shortness of breath, numbness or weakness on
 one side of your body, trouble talking, headache, or dizziness.
- tear in your stomach or intestinal wall (perforation) or bleeding.
 Symptoms may include: pain, swelling in your stomach-area, vomiting blood, and black sticky stools.
- high blood pressure including a sudden and severe rise in blood pressure
 which may be life-threatening
- 689 Have someone call your healthcare provider or get medical help right
- 690 **away** for you, if you get symptoms of a severe increase in blood pressure,691 including:
- severe chest pain, severe headache, nausea and vomiting, severe anxiety,
- 693 shortness of breath, seizures, or you pass out (become unconscious).
- 694 thyroid problems. Your healthcare provider may check you for this during
 695 treatment with VOTRIENT.

- 697 Call your healthcare provider right away, if you have any of the symptoms698 listed above.

- 700 The most common side effects of VOTRIENT include:
- 701 diarrhea
- 702 change in hair color
- 703 nausea or vomiting
- 704 loss of appetite

700	Tell your healthcare provider if you have any side effect that bothers you or that

710	These are not all the possible side effects of VOTRIENT. For more information, ask

716	How should I store VOTRIENT tablets?
717	Store VOTRIENT at room temperature between 68°F and 77°F (20°C to 25°C).

719	Keep VOTRIENT and all medicines out of the reach of children.

721	General information about the safe and effective use of VOTRIENT:
722	Medicines are sometimes prescribed for purposes other than those listed in a
723	Medication Guide. Do not use VOTRIENT for a condition for which it was not
724 725	prescribed. Do not give VOTRIENT to other people even if they have the same
725 726	symptoms that you have. It may harm them.
