Miconazole nitrate
(200 mg in each suppository) Vaginal antifungal
Miconazole nitrate 2% (external cream) Vaginal antifungal

Purpose
Vaginal antifungal

Uses
■ treats vaginal yeast infections ■ relieves external
itching and irritation due to a vaginal yeast infection

Warnings
For vaginal use only
Do not use if you have never had a vaginal yeast infection
diagnosed by a doctor.
Ask a doctor before use if you have
■ vaginal itching and discomfort for the first time
■ lower abdominal, back or shoulder pain, fever, chills, nausea,
vomiting, or foul-smelling vaginal discharge. You may have a
more serious condition.
■ vaginal yeast infections often (such as once a month or 3 in 6
months). You could be pregnant or have a serious underlying
medical cause for your symptoms, including diabetes, or a
weakened immune system.
■ been exposed to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) that
causes AIDS
Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are taking the
prescription blood thinning medicine warfarin, because bleeding
or bruising may occur.
■ do not use tampons, douches, spermicides or other vaginal
products. Condoms and diaphragms may be damaged and fail
to prevent pregnancy or sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).

Directions
before using this product read the enclosed consumer information
leaflet for complete directions and information.
■ adults and children 12 years of age and over:
-suppositories: insert 1 suppository into the vagina at bedtime for
three nights in a row. Throw applicator away after use.
-external cream: squeeze a small amount of cream onto your
finger tip. Apply the cream onto the itchy, irritated skin outside the
vagina. Use 2 times daily for up to 7 days, as needed.
■ children under 12 years of age: ask a doctor.

Other information
■ do not use if printed suppository blisters are torn, open or
incompletely sealed
■ do not use if seal over tube opening has been punctured
■ do not purchase if carton is open
■ store at 20°-25°C (68°-77°F)

Inactive ingredients
suppository: hydrogenated vegetable oil base
external cream: benzoic acid, cetyl alcohol, isopropyl myristate,
polyorbate 60, potassium hydroxide, propylene glycol, purified
water, stearyl alcohol

Drug Facts (continued)
■ do not have vaginal intercourse
■ mild increase in vaginal burning, itching or irritation may occur
■ if you do not get complete relief ask a doctor before using
another product
Stop use and ask a doctor if:
■ symptoms do not get better in 3 days
■ symptoms last more than 7 days
■ you get a rash or hives, abdominal pain, fever, chills, nausea,
vomiting, or foul-smelling vaginal discharge
If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.
Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, get medical help or
contact a Poison Control Center right away.
