Liver problems:

- Nausea or vomiting
- Stomach pain
- Unusual tiredness
- Not wanting to eat
- Yellowing of the skin or whites of your eyes
- Dark urine

Immune system problems:

- Skin reactions such as rash or skin irritation
- Tender, painful, or swollen lymph nodes
- Intestinal problems (colitis). Symptoms can include fever, stomach pain, blood in your stools, or diarrhea that does not go away
- Any new and unexplained symptoms affecting any part of your body
