Dear Mr. Schlag:

Please refer to your supplemental new drug application dated April 3, 2007, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for Cordarone (amiodarone HCl) 200 mg Tablets.

This "Changes Being Effected" supplemental new drug application provides for labeling revised as follows:

1. Under ADVERSE REACTIONS/Postmarketing Reports, the following information has been added to the list of conditions reported:

“...parkinsonian symptoms such as akinesia and bradykinesia (sometimes reversible with discontinuation of therapy)...”

2. The item number and revision date have been updated.

We have completed our review of this supplemental new drug application. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the final printed labeling (FPL) submitted on April 3, 2007.
