Please refer to your new drug application (NDA) dated May 15, 2009, received May 15, 2009, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for Cymbalta (duloxetine hydrochloride), 20, 30, and 60 mg Capsules.

We acknowledge receipt of your amendments dated July, 31, August 4 and 14, September 15, October 7 and 19, 2009, January 11, 15, 25, and 26, February 2 and 8, March 8, May 28, June 11, July 19, August 6, September 13, and October 1, 6, and 14, 2010.

This new drug application provides for the use of Cymbalta (duloxetine hydrochloride) Capsules for the management of chronic musculoskeletal pain, as demonstrated in studies in patients with chronic low back pain and chronic pain due to osteoarthritis.

We have completed our review of this application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the agreed-upon labeling text as indicated in the enclosed agreed-upon labeling text.

We request that the labeling approved today be available on your website within 10 days of receipt of this letter.

We are waiving the requirements of 21 CFR 201.57(d)(8) regarding the length of Highlights of prescribing information. This waiver applies to all future supplements containing revised labeling unless we notify you otherwise.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit, via the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format, as described at <http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm>, that is identical to, except with the revisions listed/indicated, the enclosed labeling (text for the package

insert, text for the patient package insert, Medication Guide). Information on submitting SPL files using eLIST may be found in the guidance for industry titled “SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As” at <http://www.fda.gov/downloads/Drugs/GuidanceComplianceRegulatoryInformation/Guidances/UCM072392.pdf>.

The SPL will be accessible via publicly available labeling repositories.

CARTON AND IMMEDIATE CONTAINER LABELS

We acknowledge your January 11, 2010, submission containing final printed carton and container labels.

Marketing the product with FPL that is not identical to the approved labeling text may render the product misbranded and an unapproved new drug.

REQUIRED PEDIATRIC ASSESSMENTS

Under the Pediatric Research Equity Act (PREA) (21 U.S.C. 355c), all applications for new active ingredients, new indications, new dosage forms, new dosing regimens, or new routes of administration are required to contain an assessment of the safety and effectiveness of the product for the claimed indication(s) in pediatric patients unless this requirement is waived, deferred, or inapplicable.

We are waiving the pediatric study requirement for this application because the necessary studies would be impossible or highly impracticable to conduct. There is a low incidence of chronic musculoskeletal pain due to chronic low back pain and pain due to osteoarthritis in pediatric patients; therefore, conducting the necessary studies would be highly impractical.

RISK EVALUATION AND MITIGATION STRATEGY REQUIREMENTS

We acknowledge receipt of your voluntary submission dated May 15, 2009, of a proposed risk evaluation and mitigation strategy (REMS). We have determined that, at this time, a REMS is not necessary for Cymbalta to ensure that its benefits outweigh its risks. We will notify you if we become aware of new safety information and make a determination that a REMS is necessary.

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit, in triplicate, a cover letter requesting advisory comments, the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and the package insert to:
