Dear Mr. Kang:

Please refer to your Supplemental Biologics License Application (sBLA), dated December 11, 2012, received December 12, 2012, submitted under section 351(a) of the Public Health Service Act for PEGASYS<sup>®</sup> (peginterferon alfa-2a).

We acknowledge receipt of your amendments dated January 28, March 26, April 25 and May 14, 2013.

This “Prior Approval” sBLA proposes the following changes:

1. Deletion of all references to ribavirin as a potential carcinogen from the Prescribing Information (PI) in response to FDA’s Prior Approval Supplement Request letter dated November 2, 2012.
2. Correction of a typographical error to match the numbering of studies (Study 6 versus Study 7).
3. Alignment of item #22 in the Instruction for Use (IFU) Pegasys Solution for Injection Prefilled Syringe with the needle manufacturer’s (b) (4) product labeling (b) (4)

We have completed our review of this supplemental application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

**CONTENT OF LABELING**

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit, via the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), the content of labeling [21 CFR 601.14(b)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format, as described at <http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm>, that is

identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert, Medication Guide) and include the labeling changes proposed in any pending “Changes Being Effected” (CBE) supplements. Information on submitting SPL files using eLIST may be found in the guidance for industry titled “SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As” at <http://www.fda.gov/downloads/Drugs/GuidanceComplianceRegulatoryInformation/Guidances/UCM072392.pdf>.

The SPL will be accessible via publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that includes labeling changes for this BLA, including pending “Changes Being Effected” (CBE) supplements, for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 601.12(f)] in MS Word format that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application.

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit, in triplicate, a cover letter requesting advisory comments, the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and the package insert(s) to:
