Dear Dr. Bliecq:

Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated February 27, 2015, received February 27, 2015, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for Zelboraf (vemurafenib), tablet; 240 mg.

We acknowledge receipt of your amendments dated April 10, 2015, June 26, 2015, July 7, 2015, and July 30, 2015.

This "Prior Approval" supplemental new drug application provides for the following changes to the label:

- Add a new WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS subsection (5.10) entitled, "Radiation Sensitization and Radiation Recall" to include information on radiation sensitization and recall with specific precaution.
- Update the ADVERSE REACTIONS subsection (6.2), Postmarketing Experience to include statements regarding radiation injury and pancreatitis.
- Add a new DRUG INTERACTIONS subsection (7.4) entitled, "Effect of Vemurafenib on P-gp Substrates" to provide information on the effects of using P-gp substrate drugs with Zelboraf.
- Update CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY subsection (12.3) Pharmacokinetics, *Drug Interaction Studies* to include information on the effect of vemurafenib on transporters
- Update the PATIENT COUNSELING INFORMATION section (17) to include information regarding potentiation of radiation toxicity with Zelboraf treatment.
- Add information in the MEDICATION GUIDE regarding the worsening of radiation treatment side effects with Zelboraf treatment.

APPROVAL & LABELING

We have completed our review of this supplemental application. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert and Medication Guide), with the addition of any labeling changes in pending "Changes Being Effected" (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that includes labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

REQUIRED PEDIATRIC ASSESSMENTS

Under the Pediatric Research Equity Act (PREA) (21 U.S.C. 355c), all applications for new active ingredients, new indications, new dosage forms, new dosing regimens, or new routes of administration are required to contain an assessment of the safety and effectiveness of the product for the claimed indication(s) in pediatric patients unless this requirement is waived, deferred, or inapplicable.

Because this drug product for this indication has an orphan drug designation, you are exempt from this requirement.

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit, in triplicate, a cover letter requesting advisory comments, the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and the package insert(s) to:
