Please refer to your following Supplemental New Drug Applications (sNDAs) and your amendments, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for VICOPROFEN (hydrocodone bitartrate and ibuprofen) Tablets.

We also refer to our letter dated July 9, 2015, notifying you, under Section 505(o)(4) of the FDCA, of new safety information that we believe should be included in the labeling for the class of Nonsteroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs). This new safety information pertains to the risks of Cardiovascular Thrombotic Events and Heart Failure and Edema.

Additionally, we refer to our letter dated March 22, 2016, notifying you, under Section 505(o)(4) of the FDCA, of new safety information that we believe should be included in the labeling for VICOPROFEN Tablets. This information pertains to the risks of misuse, abuse, addiction, overdose, death, and neonatal opioid withdrawal syndrome; serotonin syndrome with concomitant use of serotonergic drugs; adrenal insufficiency; and androgen deficiency.

Finally, we refer to our letter dated August 31, 2016, notifying you, under Section 505(o)(4) of the FDCA, of new safety information that we believe should be included in the labeling for VICOPROFEN Tablets. This information pertains to the risks of concomitant use of opioid analgesics with benzodiazepines or other central nervous system depressants.

Supplement S-012 provides for changes to the VICOPROFEN Tablets labeling to reflect the rescheduling of hydrocodone-containing products from schedule III into schedule II of the

Controlled Substances Act, in accordance with the final rule published in Federal Register on August 22, 2014, by the Drug Enforcement Administration.

Supplement S-013 provides for the Safety Labeling Changes required under Section 505(o)(4) of the FDCA, for the class of NSAIDs, consistent with our July 9, 2015, letter.

Supplement S-014 proposes additional revisions to the Package Insert to incorporate NSAID analgesic product class template language, consistent with our July 9, 2015, letter.

Supplement S-015 provides for the Safety Labeling Changes required under Section 505(o)(4) of the FDCA, consistent with our March 22 and August 31, 2016, letters.

Supplement S-016 proposes additional revisions to the Package Insert to incorporate the opioid analgesic class template language, consistent with our March 22, 2016, letter.

APPROVAL & LABELING

We have completed our review of these supplemental applications, as amended. They are approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling text, with the addition of any labeling changes in pending "Changes Being Effected" (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

Marketing the product(s) with FPL that is not identical to the approved labeling text may render the product misbranded and an unapproved new drug.

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. To do so, submit the following, in triplicate, (1) a cover letter requesting advisory comments, (2) the proposed materials in draft or mock-up form with annotated references, and (3) the package insert(s) to:
