Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated and received, August 10, 2016 submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for Forfivo XL (bupropion hydrochloride) Extended Release Tablets, 450 mg.

This "Changes Being Effected" supplemental new drug application provides for revisions to the product labeling for consistency with the reference listed drug, Wellbutrin XL, and for the addition of the following statement in Section 9.2 Abuse – Humans:

Bupropion hydrochloride extended-release tablets are intended for oral use only. The inhalation of crushed tablets or injection of dissolved bupropion has been reported. Seizures and/or cases of death have been reported when bupropion has been administered intranasally or by parenteral injection.

We have completed our review of this supplemental application, and it is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.
