Dear Ms. Ramcharitar:

Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated and received June 23, 2017, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for Capoten (captopril) tablets, 12.5 mg, 25 mg, 50 mg, and 100 mg Tablets.

This supplemental new drug application provides for the following changes to the approved labeling:

1. Under **CONTRAINDICATIONS**, the following text was added:

CAPOTEN is contraindicated in combination with a neprilysin inhibitor (e.g., sacubitril). Do not administer Capoten within 36 hours of switching to or from sacubitril/valsartan, a nepriltsin inhibitor (see **PRECAUTIONS**, **Drug Interactions**).

2. Under **WARNINGS**, **Head and Neck Angioedema**, the following text was added to the third paragraph:

Patients receiving coadministration of ACE inhibitor and mTOR (mammalian target of rapamycin) inhibitor (e.g., temsirolimus, sirolimus, everolimus) therapy <u>or a neprilysin inhibitor</u> may be at increased risk for angioedema (see **PRECAUTIONS**, **Drug Interactions**).

3. Under **DRUG INTERACTIONS** the following section was added:

<u>Neprilysin Inhibitor:</u> Patients taking concomitant neprilysin inhibitors may be at increased risk for angioedema (See WARNINGS, Head and Neck Angioedema).

- 4. The Manufacturing address was updated.
- 5. The revision date and version number were updated.

There are no other changes from the last approved package insert

APPROVAL & LABELING

We have completed our review of this supplemental application and it is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(1)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at

http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert), with the addition of any labeling changes in pending "Changes Being Effected" (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling.
