Dear Dr. Wagner:

Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated March 28, 2016, received March 28, 2016, and your amendments, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for EVOTAZ™ (atazanavir/cobicistat) tablets 300/150 mg.

This Prior Approval supplemental new drug application proposes the following changes to the labeling for EVOTAZ:

- To update the WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS, ADVERSE REACTIONS, CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY, and CLINICAL STUDIES sections with clinical information from week 144 data from study GS-US-216-0114.
- To update the DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION section with additional information regarding the use of Evotaz in patients with hepatic and renal impairment.
- To update the CONTRAINDICATIONS section with elbasvir/grazoprevir information.
- To update the USE IN SPECIFIC POPULATIONS and PATIENT COUNSELING INFORMATION sections according to the Pregnancy and Lactation Labeling Rule.
- To update the CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY section with additional cardiac electrophysiology information and to reformat the Absorption, Distribution, Metabolism, and Excretion information in the Pharmacokinetics subsection.
- To delete telaprevir information from the labeling because it is no longer marketed or distributed in the United States.

## **APPROVAL & LABELING**

We have completed our review of this supplemental application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

## **WAIVER OF HIGHLIGHTS SECTION**

Please note that we have previously granted a waiver of the requirements of 21 CFR 201.57(d)(8) regarding the length of Highlights of prescribing information.

## **CONTENT OF LABELING**

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at <http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm>. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling text for the package insert and text for the patient package insert, with the addition of any labeling changes in pending “Changes Being Effected” (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

Information on submitting SPL files using eList may be found in the guidance for industry titled “SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As at <http://www.fda.gov/downloads/DrugsGuidanceComplianceRegulatoryInformation/Guidances/UCM072392.pdf>

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. Within 7 days of receipt of this letter, submit your statement of intent to comply with 21 CFR 314.70(a)(4) to the address above, by fax to 301-847-8444, or electronically in eCTD format.
