Dear Mr. Garikpati:

Please refer to your Supplemental New Drug Application (sNDA) dated and, received November 3, 2017, and your amendments, submitted under section 505(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FDCA) for Ella (ulipristal acetate) tablets, 30 mg.

This Prior Approval supplemental new drug application provides for updates to reflect the results of the fulfilled pregnancy outcome post-marketing required (PMR) study and also to comply with the recent Pregnancy Lactation Labeling Rule (PLLR) requirements. These include the following revisions:

- Section 4 CONTRAINDICATIONS: The language about unknown risk to fetus in pregnancy was deleted since these data are now available in the Clinical Study Report from PMR 1673-1.
- Section 5.1 Existing Pregnancy: The language related to pregnancy exclusion/testing before prescribing ella and references to the web based study was deleted as this is no longer applicable.
- Section 8.1 Pregnancy: Revised per the agreed language and data.
- Section 8.2 Changed to Lactation: A risk summary statement was added per PLLR.
- Section 17 PATIENT COUNSELING INFORMATION: Deleted the reference to the web based study ([www.ellipse2.com](http://www.ellipse2.com)).
- FDA-Approved Patient Labeling Patient Information: Updated to reflect changes to Prescribing Information.

**APPROVAL & LABELING**

We have completed our review of this supplemental application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed, agreed-upon labeling text.

## **CONTENT OF LABELING**

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format using the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), as described at <http://www.fda.gov/ForIndustry/DataStandards/StructuredProductLabeling/default.htm>. Content of labeling must be identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the package insert, and text for the patient package insert), with the addition of any labeling changes in pending “Changes Being Effected” (CBE) supplements, as well as annual reportable changes not included in the enclosed labeling.

Information on submitting SPL files using eList may be found in the guidance for industry titled “SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As” at <http://www.fda.gov/downloads/DrugsGuidanceComplianceRegulatoryInformation/Guidances/UCM072392.pdf>.

The SPL will be accessible from publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this NDA, including CBE supplements for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 314.50(l)(1)(i)] in MS Word format, that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes and annotate each change. To facilitate review of your submission, provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

## **REQUIRED PEDIATRIC ASSESSMENTS**

Under the Pediatric Research Equity Act (PREA) (21 U.S.C. 355c), all applications for new active ingredients (which includes new salts and new fixed combinations), new indications, new dosage forms, new dosing regimens, or new routes of administration are required to contain an assessment of the safety and effectiveness of the product for the claimed indication in pediatric patients unless this requirement is waived, deferred, or inapplicable.

Because none of these criteria apply to your application, you are exempt from this requirement.
