MONISTAT® 3 Vaginal Cream is a 3-day treatment that cures most vaginal yeast infections. If this is the <u>first</u> time you have had vaginal itching and discomfort, consult your doctor. If you have had a doctor diagnose a vaginal yeast infection before and have the same symptoms now, use this cream as directed for 3 days in a row.

Active Ingredient: miconazole nitrate (200 mg per applicator).

Use: For the treatment of vaginal yeast infections (candidiasis).

Warnings:

- For vaginal use only. Do not use in eyes or take by mouth.
- Do not use MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream if you have any of the following signs and symptoms:
 - fever (higher than 100°F).

Inactive Ingredients: benzoic acid, cetyl alcohol, isopropyl myristate, polysorbate 60, potassium hydroxide, propylene glycol, purified water, stearyl alcohol.

Store at room temperature 15°-30°C (59°-86°F). Avoid heat over 30°C or 86°F. See end flap for lot number and expiration date.

Important: Do not purchase if carton is opened. Each applicator is individually wrapped. If wrapper is missing or damaged, <u>do not use</u>. Return the product to the store where you bought it.

Use

For the treatment of vaginal yeast infections (candidiasis).

If you have symptoms such as vaginal itching, burning, or discharge, and if at some time in the past your doctor has told you that these symptoms were due to a vaginal yeast infection, then MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream should work for you. If, however, you have never had these symptoms or a vaginal yeast infection before, you should see your doctor before using this product.

What Is A Vaginal Yeast Infection (Candidiasis)?

A yeast infection is a common type of vaginal infection. Your doctor may call it candidiasis. This condition is caused by an organism called Candida, which is a type of yeast. Healthy women usually have this yeast on the skin, in the mouth, in the digestive tract, and in the vagina. At times, the yeast can grow very quickly. In fact, the infection is sometimes called yeast (Candida) "overgrowth". Some women may have a yeast infection on the skin outside the vagina (vulva) associated with the vaginal infection.

A yeast infection can occur at any age. It is most common during the childbearing years. Women who are pregnant or diabetic, taking antibiotics, birth control pills or steroids, or who have a weakened immune system are more likely to get repeated yeast infections.

Various medical conditions can damage the body's normal defenses against infection. One of the most serious of these conditions is infection with the human immuno-deficiency virus (HIV - the virus that causes AIDS). The HIV virus causes the body to be more likely to get infections, including vaginal yeast infections. Therefore, women with HIV infection may have frequent vaginal yeast infections that do not clear up easily with proper treatment. If you may have been exposed to HIV and are experiencing repeated vaginal yeast infections, you should see your doctor right away. Symptoms of A Vaginal Yeast Infection

There are many signs and symptoms of a vaginal yeast infection. They can include:

- Vaginal itching (ranging from mild to severe).
- A clumpy, vaginal discharge that may look like cottage cheese.
- Vaginal soreness, irritation, or burning.
- Rash or redness on the skin outside the vagina (vulvar irritation).

Note: Vaginal discharge that is different from above, for example, a yellow/green discharge or a foul-smelling discharge may mean that you have a different infection. If this is the case, you should consult your doctor before using MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream.

Warnings

Adverse Reactions (Side Effects)

A mild increase in vaginal burning, itching, or irritation may occur when MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream is inserted. Abdominal cramping has also been reported. Stop using MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream and consult your doctor if you have abdominal pain, hives, or skin rash, or if you have severe vaginal burning, itching, or irritation.

For Best Results

- 1. Be sure to use all three prefilled applicators even if your symptoms go away before three days.
- 2. Use one prefilled applicator at bedtime for three days in a row, even during your menstrual period.

- 3. Wear cotton underwear.
- 4. If your partner has itching, redness or discomfort of his penis, he should consult his doctor. He should tell the doctor that you are treating yourself for a vaginal yeast infection.
- 5. Dry the outside vaginal area thoroughly after a shower, bath or swim. Change out of a wet bathing suit or damp clothes as soon as possible. A dry area is less likely to lead to the growth of yeast.
- 6. Wipe from front to rear after a bowel movement or urination.
- 7. Do not douche unless your doctor tells you to do so. Douching may wash the product out of the vagina.
- 8. Try not to scratch the skin outside the vagina. Scratching can cause more irritation and can spread the infection.
- 9. Discuss with your doctor any drugs you are now taking. You are more likely to get a vaginal yeast infection with certain drugs.
- 10. Do not have vaginal intercourse while using this product.

The following are the instructions for use for MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream in Prefilled Applicators.

Directions For Use

Begin treatment before going to bed:

- 1. Unscrew and remove blue cap from prefilled applicator.
- 2. Insert plunger into prefilled applicator by placing small end of plunger into the grey hole at the end of the applicator.

(Illustration) [Label plunger and barrel]

3. Gently insert the applicator into the vagina as far back as it will go comfortably. This can be done while lying on your back with your knees bent (as shown in the picture), or while standing with your feet apart and your knees bent.

(Illustration) [Label vagina, uterus, and rectum.]

With one hand holding the barrel use the other hand to push the plunger all the way in to place all the cream as far back in the vagina as possible. Then remove both parts of the applicator from the vagina. Throw away applicator after each use. Do not flush in toilet.

- 4. You should lie down as soon as possible after inserting the cream. This will reduce leakage.
- 5. Repeat steps 1 though 4 before going to bed for the next two days.

You may want to use deodorant-free minipads or pantyshields during the time that you are using MONISTAT 3 Vaginal Cream. This is because the cream can leak or you may see some discharge. Do not use tampons, douches, or spermicides until after you have completed treatment and your symptoms are gone.
