

Draft Guidance on Succimer

October 2024

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Active Ingredient: Succimer

Dosage Form: Capsule

Route: Oral

Strength: 100 mg

Recommended Study: One in vivo bioequivalence study with pharmacokinetic endpoints

1. Type of study: Fasting
Design: Single-dose, two-treatment, two-period crossover in vivo
Strength: 100 mg
Subjects: Healthy males and non-pregnant, non-lactating females
Additional comments: Ensure an adequate washout period between treatments in the crossover study due to the long elimination half-life of succimer. Alternatively, a parallel study design may be considered.

Analytes to measure: Total succimer (meso-2,3- dimercaptosuccinic acid (DMSA)) including unaltered and altered in plasma

Bioequivalence based on (90% CI): Total DMSA

Waiver request of in vivo testing: Not applicable

Dissolution test method and sampling times: The dissolution information for this drug product can be found in the FDA's Dissolution Methods database, <http://www.accessdata.fda.gov/scripts/cder/dissolution/>. Conduct comparative dissolution testing on 12 dosage units for each of the test product and reference listed drug (RLD).¹ Specifications will be determined upon review of the abbreviated new drug application.
